### Additional Features of the Student Sample

- On the basis of age, the largest group of Boys (797, 12.7% of total boys in sample) is Age 15.
- On the basis of age, the largest group of Girls (913, 13.7% of total girls in sample) is Age 17.
- On the basis of grade, the largest group of Boys (826, 13.1% of total boys in sample) is in Grade 9.
- On the basis of grade, the largest group of Girls (919, 13.7% of total girls in sample) is in Grade 9.
- On the basis of ethnic background and grade, the largest group of African-Americans is in Grade 6 (144, 11.4% of Grade 6 distribution).
- On the basis of ethnic background and grade, the largest group of Asians is in Grade 11 (77, 4.5% of Grade 11 distribution).
- On the basis of ethnic background and grade, the largest group of Hispanics is in Grades 9 and 12 both (27, 1.6% of Grades 9 and 12 distribution).
- On the basis of ethnic background and grade, the largest group of Mixed Race is in Grade 5 (82, 8.9% of Grade 5 distribution).
- On the basis of ethnic background and grade, the largest group of Native Americans is in Grade 9 (77, 0.9% of Grade 9 distribution).
- On the basis of ethnic background and grade, the largest group of White is in Grade 12 (1458, 84.8% of Grade 12 distribution).
- While in the overall sample there were more girls than boys responding, more boys than girls responded (52.6 v 47.4%) from Academic Watch schools
- While in the overall sample there were more girls than boys responding, more boys than girls responded (52.6 v 47.4%) from Large City schools.
- In Academic Watch schools, the largest group of respondents was Age 16 (103, 34.2% of respondents from Academic Watch schools).
- In Continuous Improvement schools, the largest group of respondents was Age 13 (520, 31.1% of respondents from Continuous Improvement schools).
- In Effective schools, the largest group of respondents was Age 12 (544, 18.2% of respondents from Effective schools).
- In Excellent schools, the largest group of respondents was Age 15 (1151, 14.1% of respondents from Excellent schools).
- In Rural schools, the largest group of respondents was in Grade 11 (210, 16.3% of respondents in Rural schools).
- In Urban/Suburban schools, the largest group of respondents was in Grade 12 (1447, 13.6% of respondents in Urban/Suburban schools).
- In Small City schools, the largest group of respondents was in Grade 8 (177, 19.3% of respondents in Small City schools).
- In Large City schools, the largest group of respondents was in Grade 9 (99, 32.8% of respondents in Large City schools).
